
We look forward to a great year ahead as we all work together to make a difference in Australia and help it to be a drug-free nation with healthy and happy people - young and old.

Uncorked - The Hidden Hazards of Alcohol by Doctors John Ashton and Ronald S Laura

Published by Signs Publishing Company, 2004 - Reported by Joy Butler

This book is full of all the information you will ever need to answer all your and others questions about alcohol and what it is, does and means for those who consume it. I recommend that you get a copy. Ask us how to do this.

The effects of alcohol on women, on the babies they produce and the effects on children of alcoholics is clearly outlined and is a subject we should continue to emphasis. FASD is a major problem worldwide and millions of children are born every day, damaged. This damage is permanent and is irreversible and makes life very difficult for the child affected, for the families they live with and for society.

In the chapter entitled 'Pregnant Women Never Drink Alone' here are a few sentences: "Depending on the stage of development, foetal exposure to alcohol can cause permanent damage to the child. Even more frightening is the evidence

suggesting that alcohol in the bloodstream has the potential to damage the unfertilised eggs in women: In the 1700s there was a growing awareness among medical researchers that alcohol drinking by pregnant women could cause severe damage to the foetus......Despite alarming research reports, the possibility of alcohol teratogenesis (deformation of the foetus) was generally denied or largely ignored until the report of K L Jones and coworkers appeared in the Lancet on June 9, 1973...... Since the publication of this seminal paper, a vast amount of literature has corroborated the serious effects of alcohol on the unborn."

"By 1981, statistics had established FAS as a leading known cause of intellectual impairment. Within five years, however, Professors E L Abel and R J Sokol, after reviewing 19 epidemiological studies worldwide involving 164 FAS cases, concluded that the evidence is sufficient to identify FAS as the leading cause of intellectual impairment in Western culture."

".....the potential for alcohol during pregnancy to harm the normal sexual development of a child should not be ignored."

"Young drinking males are not immune from fathering deformed offspring either......alcohol in the blood can serve to poison the sperm of prospective fathers......paternal exposure to alcohol had been found to affect the growth and development of the baby."

"The notion of a duty of care to the unborn before and certainly from conception must be fostered in our community."

Drug Free Australia Statement Just released as at 16/2/2023

It is instructive to note that our position on cannabis has now changed, as of 2020, with the 2019-2022 publication of immense population studies where US States that have legalised the medical use of cannabis as well as others that have legalised its recreational use have significantly steeper increases in cancers, where cannabis is now demonstrated to be likely causal in more than twice as many cancers as smoked tobacco. Clearly no responsible medico will prescribe tobacco for any condition because of its carcinogenic nature, and with these latest findings DFA will no longer support clinical trials of any cannabinoid, including Cannabidiol (CDB), which is shown in these studies to be as implicated as other cannabinoids (12 cancers caused by CBD as compared to 14 for tobacco). Yet other very recent studies have shown that cannabis is causal in 89 of 95 birth defects tracked by the European Medicines Agency. This has been shown to be

due to the genotoxic and mutagenic nature of cannabis, where cannabis literally shatters chromosomes in cell nuclei, with faulty DNA repair mechanisms leaving wrongly coded DNA – this is the cause of cancers and congenital deformities which will continue to be passed down

to future generations. The faulty genetic makeup of both a cannabis using father and mother are implicated. It is on the grounds of the current science that DFA no longer supports medical cannabis trials.

History Snippets - No. 1 Our Godly Heritage

This is the title of a small book published in London by the World WCTU soon after 1956. Written by Dorothy Staunton, it is a Historical Review of the World's Woman's Christian Temperance Union 1883-1956. It has an outline and overview of every world convention during that time. World Conventions are held triennially and the reports from each of those conventions during that time are inspirational and amazing.

Here are some excerpts: "It was on November 18, 1874 that the USA Woman's National Christian Temperance Union was formally organised at Cleveland, Ohio. Women from eighteen states were gathered there. One hundred and thirty-five (135) were registered as accredited delegates. Frances Willard became the first Corresponding Secretary.

"There had been various temperance campaigns and gatherings of women praying before this date. Individual strong women such as Elizabeth Fry, Dorothea Dix, Harriet Beecher Stowe and Florence Nightingale, amongst others, had broken through the conventional sheltering barriers set around gentle cultured women, and swept the world. They had demonstrated a great surge of service of forgetfulness, of self and comfort. Without political status, these women did and dared more than the modern world can comprehend and did it, often with the approbation of their men-folk, and without the loss of their feminine characteristics. Not copying men's methods as the only ways, they proved they were complementary to them, making together a more perfect whole.

"By 1876 the idea of an International Women's Temperance Convention had taken hold of the imagination of some Temperance women and soon the British Temperance women and others from Japan, Canada and nearly all the States met and made tentative plans for an international organisation. This became a reality in 1884 when Mrs Margaret Bright Lucas, 3rd president of the British Women's Temperance Association was appointed World President of the World WCTU.



"In that same year 1884, Mrs Mary Clement Leavitt arranged to visit the Hawaiian islands and here was the open door to spread the message further. Mrs Leavitt was the first WCTU missionary and she made a journey around the world. With only \$35 in her purse, but in her heart the conviction that she was called to this service and that God would provide for her, she set out and her faith was justified. For 6 years and 7 months she travelled

and visited Hawaii, New Zealand, Australia, Japan, China, Siam, Straights Settlements, Burma, India, Ceylon, Mauritius, Madagascar, Africa, Great Britain, North Africa, West Africa, Madeira, Spain, France, Belgium, Holland, Germany, Finland, Italy, Greece, Egypt, Palestine, Syria, Asiatic Turkey, then to England and home to USA."

Thus the great World WCTU began and has never stopped. Our heritage is sensational, and our future is sure with God. In future editions of WRS I will give more historical reports from this inspiring book.
